Directives Governing Subsidies for the Student Altruistic Awards

December 31, 2013 Passed by the 2,793rd Administrative Meeting

- Article 1 National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) formulates the NTU *Directives Governing Subsidies for the Student Altruistic Awards* (“the Directives”) to commend students who demonstrate care for society, a spirit of altruism, and dedication to both the University and society, and to encourage each college at the University to promote its own Student Altruistic Award (“the Award”).
- Article 2 Each college shall establish a review committee to discuss and comment upon the Award. The organization of each review committee and its rules shall be determined by the establishing college. Student representatives shall be included among committee members.
- Article 3 The funds required by each college for the Award shall be drawn from the University’s Public Expense and Scholarship Fund for Students.
- Article 4 Any formally registered student at NTU who meets any of the following criteria or accomplishes any of the following deeds shall be eligible for recommendation by full-time instructors, heads of undergraduate and graduate degree programs, and student clubs and student autonomous organizations, or may apply directly to their associated college themselves as a candidate for evaluation by the review committee for a Student Altruistic Award:
1. The student demonstrates the spirit of mutual support, and takes care of and provides comfort for classmates.
 2. The student promotes a positive atmosphere at the University and serves as a role model for young people.
 3. The student enthusiastically participates in social welfare activities and promotes social innovation.
 4. Other deeds involving support and care for others
- Article 5 One out of every 200 students in a college may be selected as an awardee. However, the review committee of each college may adjust the number of award recipients or decide not to name any award recipients. After the review is complete, the review committee of each college shall select one awardee as a nominee for the NTU Social Devotion Special Award at the end of June.
- Article 6 Each awardee will receive a certificate of merit and a prize of NTD 3,000, and each awardee shall receive a public commendation by the dean of their college.
- Article 7 Each college shall submit a list of award recipients to the NTU Student Assistance Division by the end of June each year, and the disbursement of the award money shall be effected by the end of August.

Article 8 The Directives shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
