

Regulations for Establishing the National Taiwan University Social Devotion Special Award

Adopted by the 2783th executive meetings on October, 22, 2013

Amended and adopted by the 2846th executive meetings on February, 3, 2015

Article 1 National Taiwan University (NTU) has formulated this award to honor students caring for the society, demonstrating the spirit of helping others and contributing to both the school and the society.

Article 2 NTU students who devote themselves in substantial services on and off campus are qualified to be the candidates of the Social Devotion Special Award.

Article 3 The candidates can be nominated by the Student Association, Graduate Student Association or proposed by first-level administrative to the university. The awardees will receive the award after the examination of inspection committee.

If the candidates have conducted the service with a team, the candidates should be nominated by the name of the team.

Each recommending unit can only make at most one nomination for both individual and group award.

Article 4 The Social Devotion Special Award includes individual and group award. Total awardees should be at most three.

Article 5 In order to encourage the awardees to keep up their dedication, the awardees will receive a medal and a Dream Plan subsidy from the university. The awardees will also be commended in public during important school festivals.

For individual awards, each awardee will receive 100,000 NTD for the Dream Plan subsidy; while for group awards, each team will receive 300,000 NTD.

Article 6 The willingness of the individual should be considered when nominating the candidates.

Article 7 The budget of the Dream Plan subsidy will be supported by the school's "Government Sponsorship for Student and Incentive Bonus".

Article 8 The regulation shall be implemented on the announcement day after the approval of the executive meeting.
